## **To Office Bearers, State Federations and All India Bankwise Federations, All unions**

Dear Comrades,

### **AIBEA Office Bearers meeting**

Meeting of the new elected Office Bearers of AIBEA was held in Bengaluru today. All the Office Bearers participated in the meeting. The meeting was presided over by Com. B.S. Rambabu, President.

**Mass meeting:** KPBEF had arranged a mass meeting yesterday evening to introduce the new team of office bearers of AIBEA. Large number of members from Bengaluru city branches participated in this meeting. Com. Rambabu, in his address congratulated KPBEF for hosting the 30<sup>th</sup> Conference in a very successful manner and appreciated the role of the Reception Committee and all the volunteers who worked day and night and made the conference memorable.

The General Secretary, while thanking KPBEF, recalled how KPBEF had hosted the 10<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> and 30<sup>th</sup> Conference of AIBEA in Bengaluru in 1959, 1985 and 2026 in a successful manner. He spoke about the important decisions taken in the Conference and the tasks ahead and exhorted all our members to be prepared for the programmes to be undertaken by AIBEA in the days to come.

It was a matter of pleasure and pride that Com. P S Sundaresan, former leader of KPBEF was present in the meeting at the age of 97. He also greeted the newly elected office bearers of AIBEA. Similarly Com H V Rai, senior leader and former General Secretary of AIBEA was also present in the meeting.

### **Office Bearers meeting:**

There was a brief review of the proceedings of the Conference and the follow-up measures to be taken on the various decisions taken in the Conference.

The meeting adopted a Resolution thanking the Reception Committee and entire volunteers and appreciating the commendable manner in which KPBEF had hosted the Conference.

The meeting placed on record its appreciation for the services rendered by the outgoing office bearers of the previous term viz. Com. Rajen Nagar, Com. P R Mehta, Com. Lalita Joshi, Com. Jayanath Com. D R Tuljapurkar, Com. K Srikrishna, and Com. M P Singh and Com S D Srinivasan.

### **The meeting decided on the following:**

- 57<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Bank Nationalisation (19-7-2026) to be observed by all our State Federations and Unions by holding meetings, lectures and seminars in various cities and towns in all the States. These programmes are to undertaken between 10<sup>th</sup> July and 31<sup>st</sup> July, 2026.

- b. Meeting of the Sub-Committee on formulation of Charter of Demands for the 13<sup>th</sup> Bipartite Settlement to be held by end of July, 2026 to consider the suggestions received from our unions and members and finalise their recommendations.
- c. Meeting of All India Bankwise Unions in Public Sector Banks to be held at the earliest on further recruitment of CSAs, recruitment of substaff and Armed Guards and issue relating to temporary employees.
- d. Meeting of our Social Media team to be held before 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2026 to reconstitute the various sub-groups under the Social Media Team and to expand our activities.
- e. Convention of Ex-servicemen employees to be held within the next three months.
- f. All India Convention of Bank Mitras/BCs to be organized at the earliest to found an All India Organisation for them under the banner of AIBEA and to pursue their demands.
- g. All India Convention of Jewel-Gold Appraisers to be held and an All India organisation to be formed under the banner of AIBEA to pursue their demands.
- h. Special Leadership Development and Trade Union workshop to be conducted for members of AIBEA's National Women's Council.
- i. Workshop to be organized for leaders of our Unions to appraise and understand the various provisions of the new Labour Codes that have been recently implemented by the Government.
- j. Special General Council meeting of AIBEA to be held before the end of this year for reiterating and finalizing the Policy Documents for AIBEA on
  - Political Policy of AIBEA and protecting the unity and broad-based character of AIBEA.
  - Organisational structure and set-up of AIBEA and its unions at all levels.
  - Cadre Development Policy of AIBEA
  - Organisational Code to ensure proper discipline in the organisation at all levels.
  - Social Media Policy of AIBEA to restrict possible misuse.

After all State Federations submit the names of their Central Committee members, the first Central Committee meeting of AIBEA will be held in Patna.
